**Call Summary**  
*May2010*

- 5/1/10 Personnel responded to a report of a missing child behind the Windjammer. A family found the little girl and her mother was transported to the child's location.
- 5/1/10 Following a turtle release, Chief Graham found a lost child. Personnel responded and assisted in locating child's parents.
- 5/1/10 Personnel responded to and met with police units to help locate the mother of a missing child. The brother of the missing child was also lost. The children were reunited with their mother.
- 5/3/10 Personnel responded to a report of two people on Palmetto Drive locked in their condo. The dead bolt malfunctioned and was removed. The Fire Marshal was called to the scene to investigate the cause and follow up with the property manager.
- 5/12/10 Personnel responded to a resident's call of a surfer having difficulty returning to shore. The jet ski was used to check on the surfer who advised he was fine and wanted to remain in the water.
- 5/15/10 Personnel responded to a request from the Charleston County Rescue to help locate a missing boater. The beaches were checked and no sign of the boater or any possessions were found. Charleston County Rescue Command was advised and personnel departed the scene.
- 5/15/10 Personnel enroute to a call were flagged down by a resident who advised them of a missing child. The child was located and reunited with the family.
- 5/15/10 Personnel responded to a call of a kayaker in distress in the Intracoastal Waterway. Boat 1 was assisted in the search by Charleston County Rescue. The victim was found holding on to the anchor line and was assisted onto Boat 1 and returned to Isle of Palms Marina where Charleston County EMS assumed control. All watercraft was recovered and personnel returned to service.
- 5/17/10 Personnel responded to residence on Palmetto Drive to locate a missing senior citizen. Search was conducted and the missing person was located and returned to the family.
- 5/22/10 Personnel assisted a woman who pulled up to the Public Safety Building in search of a missing person. A search of the beach and calls to hospitals and surrounding jurisdictions did not turn up the individual. Missing individual awakened in the wrong home and walked home releasing personnel to return to station.

- 5/22/10 Personnel responded to Sullivan's Island's request for possible water rescue and patient care in Breach Inlet. Company arrived to find people had been pulled from water and no patient care or rescue was necessary and personnel returned to service.
- 5/23/10 Personnel responded to United States Coast Guard's request for assistance in Grey Bay getting to a grounded vessel. Isle of Palms personnel with a US Coast Guard member on board removed 2 passengers and a dog from the stuck boat, leaving behind 1 passenger who refused to leave the vessel. US Coast Guard was able to persuade the individual to leave the boat and company returned to station.
- 5/29/10 Personnel responded to a child that was unable to find the parents. Family members were located and child was reunited.
- 5/29/10 Personnel were advised of 2 missing girls 4 and 5 years old. Girls were located and returned to parents.
- 5/30/10 Personnel responded to calls of a group or groups of people stranded on the Breach Inlet sandbar. No one was in danger and all were safely waved back to land and crew returned to service.
- 5/31/10 Personnel were on the beach and were notified of a missing man who had gone for a swim and had not returned. Search grid was set up, a unit took a family member to check the house for the return of the missing individual. The male was found sleeping on the beach and no additional help was required.

## Communications Report May 2010

**May 4, 2010**

Representatives from Charleston County, Motorola, and Crown Castle addressed the Public Safety Committee and discussed the radio tower that has been proposed for installation on the Isle of Palms. The proposed tower is one of six needed to improve public safety communications in some locations in Charleston County to an acceptable level. There are three phases to the radio system upgrade project. The Isle of Palms tower, along with five others is part of Phase 1 and Phase 2.

**May 5, 2010**

Chief Graham attended a meeting along with representatives from Charleston County and the Digital Radio User Group to discuss the status of the system upgrades.

**May 6, 2010**

Chief Graham attended a Palmetto 800 semi-annual meeting in Columbia. Palmetto 800 is the statewide radio system. Topics covered included, but were not limited to: re-banding, re-banding reimbursement, system upgrades, vehicular repeaters, signal scramblers, statewide coverage, 800MHz plan, and 700MHz plan.

**May 10, 2010**

Chief Graham met with Bill Tunick of Charleston County to discuss the department's existing digital vehicular repeater as well as additional repeaters and 700MHz licensing.

**May 20, 2010**

Chief Graham met with representatives of the Isle of Palms Water Commission and Charleston County to discuss the proposed radio communications tower on Isle of Palms.

**May 24, 2010**

Chief Graham attended a Digital Radio User Group meeting at the request of the Kimball consultants. The main topics were status of consultant's review and expectations for the new system.
