Call Summary October 2010

10/4/10

Personnel responded to a possible brush fire at the Sea Cabins. The fire was on out the fire department's arrival and after some investigation it was determined the fire had been caused by some freshly laid pine straw that had blown on to a light with a broken cover. The pine straw had come in contact with the light bulb and caused a small fire. The pine straw was removed from the area, the power was secured at the electrical panel, and the area was cordoned off. The Public Works Director was notified of this incident, as well.

Personnel responded to a report of a missing person in the area of 42<sup>nd</sup> Avenue. A crew went to the caller's address to gather information, while another crew initiated a search of the beach in the immediate area. Not long after the search began a person was seen walking out of the dunes. After meeting with the person it was determined this was the person who had been reported missing. Crew drove her back to her residence.

While personnel were standing by for the annual Ecothon Challenge they were advised of a person in need of medical attention in the area of Dewees Island. Dewees Island Public Safety was notified of this report and responded as well. Patient was found and brought to the dock area on Dewees Island. Patient care was initiated and the patient was transported back to the Isle of Palms by Boat 1. Patient was turned over to Charleston County EMS for transport.

### Additional Training

All volunteer personnel received training in policy and procedure. Personnel also participated in the annual Isle of Palms Fire Prevention Parade and the display at the Sullivan's Island Fire Department.

Medical in-service training covered Patient Assessment.

Captain Bob Maibach served as the Lead Instructor for the National Fire Academy's Leadership II: Strategies for Personal Success course held at the Goose Creek Rural Fire Department.

Lieutenant Roger Eagle completed two courses of training through the International Association of Arson Investigators. The web-based classes were entitled: "Fire and Explosion Investigations;" and "The Scientific Method for Fire and Explosion Investigation."

Lieutenant Roger Eagle and Engineer Dave Micalizzi successfully completed the 80-hour FEMA Structural Collapse Specialist course taught at the South Carolina Fire Academy in Columbia.

Fire Inspector Jeff Anderson completed the NFPA's Plans Examiner I course held at the Fire Academy in Columbia.

Fire Inspector Jeff Anderson completed 13 courses of training through the International Association of Arson Investigators. The web-based classes were entitled: "Documenting the Event;" "Insurance and the Fire Investigation;" "Investigating Fatal Fires;" "The Scientific Method for Fire and Explosion Investigation;" "Wildland Fires Investigation;" "The HAZWOPER Standard;" "Postflashover Fires;" "Preparation for the Marine Fire Scene;" "Vacant and Abandoned Buildings: Hazards and Solutions;" "Arc Mapping Basics;" "Evidence Examination: What Happens at the Lab;" "Managing Complex Fire Scene Investigations;" and "Motive, Means, and Opportunity: Determining Responsibility in an Arson Case."
