Programs, Group Fitness, Summer Camp, Special Events

- July 4th Golf Cart Parade: Assisted the City and Police Department with the parade route.


Maintenance & Repairs

Participants registering for classes during the month from June 1 - June 30. RecTrac: in-house registration vs. WebTrac: online Registrations.


Total registrations for June 2024 = 451



Monthly Revenues 2024


Revenue sales brought in by programs, athletics and events. RecTrac: in-house vs WebTrac: online

Total Revenue for June 2024 = \$14,094.00




Annual Comparison

Open Gym Daily Average Visits


Participants utilizing the gymnasium for open play
