## Isle of Palms Fire Department

### Call Summary

April 2012

- 4/8/12 Personnel responded to a report of two individuals stranded on a jet ski near Capers Island, with one person suffering from a medical emergency. Boat 1020 was launched with a crew, including one member from Charleston County EMS. Upon reaching the area they met with another boater who had the individual needing medical treatment on board. That vessel continued to the City Marina, while Fire Department personnel met with the remaining individual on the jet ski. Personnel determined he was not in any danger and he declined any further assistance. Boat 1020 returned to the City Marina where the first individual was receiving medical treatment from EMS.
- 4/12/12 Personnel responded to a request from the Police Department to assist with a situation at a business on the front beach. Once on scene, the crew entered the building and ventilated smoke with a positive pressure fan. No further assistance was needed.
- 4/14/12 Personnel responded to Awendaw Fire Department Station No. 1 for a standby. Engine 1001 responded and stood by in station while crews from Awendaw extinguished a structure fire.
- 4/24/12 Personnel responded to assist Dewees Island Fire Department with a structure fire. Upon arrival, there were multiple structures involved in fire and crews were directed to protect exposures adjacent to the fire. After several hours the fire was brought under control with the assistance of several fire departments.
- 4/25/12 Personnel responded back to Dewees Island to assist with overhaul of the fire from the previous evening. Crews helped wet down piles of smoldering debris until all fire was extinguished.
- 4/26/12 After responding to a medical assist call at the City Marina, personnel were sent to investigate an alarm that was sounding at the Water Department pump station at the marina. Upon arrival, crews found smoke coming from the pump station. It was determined the fire was in a well hole inside the pump station and the power to the pump station was secured. Crews then used portable fire extinguishers to put out the fire. The fire was contained to the well and no structural damage occurred. Water Company officials were notified and the pump station was secured.
