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Isle of Palms Fire Department
Call Summary
September 2012

- 9/6/12 Personnel responded to a dock behind Yacht Harbor Court for a report of a boat sinking. Upon arrival the crew found a boat taking on water because of a small leak in the hull. A neighbor had called the owner, who lives in Charlotte, and they were on the way. The same neighbor had tried to use their own bilge pump to remove the water, but it was ineffective. Personnel used the portable trash pump to remove the water and find the leak. The leak was plugged with a rubber sprinkler wedge. The boat was secured and all units returned to service.
- 9/15/12 Personnel responded to a residence on 55th Avenue for a medical assist. Upon arrival the crew found a patient in cardiac arrest and began basic life support measures. After several minutes the patient regained a pulse and personnel continued to rescue breath for the patient. When EMS arrived the patient was loaded for transport to a medical facility with fire personnel continuing to provide rescue breathing for the patient.
- 9/19/12 Personnel responded to the beach behind Ocean Point for a report of a swimmer in distress. Upon arrival crews found the victim about 300 yards from shore. Boat 10 Bravo was launched and quickly retrieved the victim from the water. The victim was returned to the shore where personnel provided medical assistance.
- 9/22/12 Personnel responded to a report of a structure fire on Conch Court. Upon arrival crews found the fire had been extinguished by the residents. The fire was caused by a cooker being used inside the garage. The oil was being heated for a fish fry. A garage door and a portion of the ceiling in the garage were damaged. The building was ventilated with a positive pressure fan. No fire extension was found and all units returned to service.
- 9/25/12 Personnel responded to a report of a passenger vehicle on fire at the intersection of Palm Boulevard and 30th Avenue. Upon arrival crews found fire and smoke in the passenger compartment, and quickly extinguished the fire. The vehicle was towed from the scene and all units returned to service.


