The following is a synopsis of some of the activities of the Isle of Palms Police Department during the month of August, 2012.

**(August 1: Wednesday)**

Forcible Fondling: JC Long Boulevard. Victim reported that a patron of the business grabbed her posterior and fondled her private area, over her clothing. The case was assigned to the Criminal Investigations Division. The perpetrator was identified and a warrant was obtained for his arrest.

**(August 2: Thursday)**

Burglary: 600 block of Ocean Boulevard. A victim reported that unknown suspect(s) entered into his residence and stole various alcoholic drinks from an ice chest and refrigerator. There was no forensic evidence indicating forced entry. A witness stated that she observed a black male and a white female at the residence during the time frame of the incident. The case was assigned to the Criminal Investigations Division.

**(August 3: Friday)**

Petit Larceny: 700 block of Palm Boulevard. A victim reported that an iPad was stolen while she was vacationing on the Isle of Palms. The iPad was discovered missing after two younger family members visited the victim at the residence. The case has been assigned to the Criminal Investigations Division.

Alcohol Violation: Waterway Boulevard @ Duck Lane. While conducting routine patrol in the area of Waterway Boulevard and Duck Lane, an Officer observed a vehicle traveling at a rate of speed higher than that posted. After conducting a traffic stop, and while interviewing the driver, the Officer observed an open container of alcoholic beverage within immediate reach of the operator. The subject was placed under arrest and charged accordingly.

**(August 4: Saturday)**

Narcotics Violation/Alcohol Violation: 1100 block of Palm Boulevard. While conducting routine patrol in the 1100 block of Palm Boulevard, an Officer observed a vehicle with inoperable equipment. The Officer conducted a traffic stop and while speaking with the driver observed a glass pipe, commonly used for smoking marijuana, in plain view that was stored in the open compartment area of the center console.

**(August 5: Sunday)**

Petit Larceny: Beach@10th Avenue. A victim reported that he left his shorts, unsecured, on the beach to go into the surf for a swim. When he returned to retrieve his shorts which contained his wallet and iPhone, he discovered that unknown person(s) had stolen them.

Petit Larceny: Beach@21st Avenue. Victim reported that unknown suspect(s) stole five (5) beach chairs that had been left unattended while he walked on the beach.

**(August 6: Monday)**

Disorderly Conduct/Alcohol Violation: Ocean Boulevard (Front Beach). An Officer observed a male subject traveling along Ocean Boulevard with an open container of beer. The intoxicated subject disregarded the Officer's verbal commands to stop and began yelling profanity. Consequently, the subject was placed under arrest and transported to the Charleston County Detention Center.

Burglary: 900 block of Ocean Boulevard. A victim reported that unknown person(s) entered into the enclosed, yet unsecured garage area of his residence and stole his golf clubs.

**(August 7: Tuesday)**

Theft of Motor Vehicle: 3900 block of Palm Boulevard. The victim stated that his son left his Eco motorized scooter unsecured on the exterior of the residence. Approximately two days later, discovered it missing.

**(August 8: Wednesday)**

Petit Larceny: 2800 block of Palm Boulevard. A "No Parking" sign, purchased and posted by the victim was stolen by unknown person(s).

Possession of False Identification: 1500 block of Palm Boulevard. Officers were dispatched to a local business in reference to a subject attempting to purchase liquor with a fake ID. Upon arrival, Officers positively identified a 17 year old, visiting from Georgia, who had passed a fraudulent Illinois ID card to purchase liquor. The subject was charged with possession of a false ID.

**(August 9: Thursday)**

Harassment: 800 block of Palm Boulevard. An Officer met with a complainant/victim at the Isle of Palms Public Safety Building regarding harassment and threatening telephone calls. The victim reported that he has constantly received harassing phone calls and text messages from his brother-in-law for approximately three years. As of late, according to the victim, the frequency and intensity has

escalated. Additionally, the suspect has started driving past the victim's residence. The case has been assigned to the Criminal Investigations Division.

**(August 10: Friday)**

Petit Larceny: 1100 block of Ocean Boulevard. A local business reported that two female subjects left the establishment without paying their bill for food and drinks.

**(August 11: Saturday)**

Petit Larceny: 1000 block of Ocean Boulevard. Two victims reported that unknown person(s) stole their purses and wallets while they were patrons at a local business.

**(August 14: Tuesday)**

Petit Larceny: 1200 block of Palm Boulevard. A victim reported that unknown person(s) stole an Adirondak bench from in front of her business.

**(August 16: Thursday)**

Theft From Motor Vehicle: 2200 block of Hartnett Boulevard. During an investigation of numerous incidents of larceny from a motor vehicle cases, Investigators identified an additional victim.

**(August 17: Friday)**

Vandalism: Ocean Club Villas. Unknown person(s) damaged the entrance gate arm.

Vandalism: 1500 block of Palm Boulevard. A witness reported seeing a white male subject spray painting on the exterior walls of the vacant Pelican Cleaners building. The perpetrator was later identified however, the owner of the property did not wish to pursue charges.

Vandalism: 1000 block of Carolina Boulevard. The victim reported that unknown person(s) damaged her vehicle by causing damage to the paint, by what appeared to be the result of keying.

Burglary: Sandcrab Court. A victim reported that unknown person(s) entered into his un-enclosed garage and stole the battery from his boat.

**(August 18: Saturday)**

Petit Larceny: Grand Pavilion. A brass basket was stolen from the front porch area of the victim's residence.

**(August 19: Sunday)**

Petit Larceny: 600 block of Ocean Boulevard. The victim reported that unknown person(s) stole two docking stations from his rental residence. There were no indications of forced entry.

**(August 20: Monday)**

Petit Larceny: 1200 block of Palm Boulevard. The complaint advised that unknown subject(s) stole two orange safety cones he had placed around his business truck, while making a delivery at a local business.

**(August 21: Tuesday)**

Petit Larceny: Palmetto Drive. A victim reported that unknown suspect(s) stole an iPad from within her rental unit. There were no indications of forced entry.

Petit Larceny: 20th Avenue. Victim reported that unknown person(s) stole a lawn mower from her front yard. A witness observed a suspicious vehicle at the residence during the time frame of the theft and took a photo of the vehicle with her cell phone. The case has been assigned to the Criminal Investigations Division and a BOLO has been prepared and distributed.

**(August 23: Thursday)**

Petit Larceny: Palmetto Drive. A victim reported that unknown subject(s) stole a violin from her rental unit while she was visiting the Isle of Palms.

**(August 29: Wednesday)**

Petit Larceny: 57<sup>th</sup> Avenue. The victim reported that he and a representative of a local rental agency who manages his rental property, responded to the residence to conduct a post-check out survey. During a walk-through of the residence, he discovered a number of framed artwork and statutes missing. There were no indications of forced entry.

**Patrol**

During the month of August 2012, Officers issued 10 Business Check notices to business owners/employees advising them that the business was found unsecure. There were 43 Victim of Crime forms completed.

**Community Service:**

During the month of August, the first two meetings, kicking off the new community service program "Neighborhood Block Meet & Greet" were held on August 23<sup>rd</sup> and 30<sup>th</sup>. The first meeting was aimed at residents on 27<sup>th</sup>, 28<sup>th</sup> and 29<sup>th</sup> Avenues, as well as those in the 2700-2900 blocks of Hartnett and Cameron Boulevards. The gathering took place at the corner of 28<sup>th</sup> Avenue and Hartnett Boulevard on the Recreation Department soccer fields. The second meeting was held in the parking lot of the St. Mark's Lutheran Church (300 Palm Boulevard) and targeted the residents on 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue, 3<sup>rd</sup> Avenue, 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue and 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue and those in the 100-500 blocks of Charleston Boulevard and Carolina Boulevards.

Officers begin going door to door two days prior to the scheduled event to hand out flyers with the program information. The event is also posted on the City of Isle of Palms website. We have received positive feedback from citizens that have attended the gatherings. Four more meetings are scheduled for September.
