The following is a synopsis of some of the activities of the Isle of Palms Police Department during the month of October, 2012.

(October 3: Wednesday)

Burglary: Palmetto Drive. The victim reported that three (3) televisions had been stolen from his secondary residence. There were no indications of forced entry and a rear glass door was found to be unsecured. However, the victim stated that he was certain he secured the residence during his last visit on 09/22/12.

(October 4: Thursday)

Harassing Telephone Calls: J. C. Long Boulevard.

An employee at a local business received a number of harassing and threatening telephone calls, believed to have been made by past employees of the business.

(October 5: Friday)

Petit Larceny: 41st Avenue.

An unsecured bicycle was stolen from the front yard of a 41st Avenue residence.

(October 08: Monday)

Grand Larceny: 12-33429. Boardwalk Inn. A victim reported that she left a bag containing jewelry in the room safe, upon checking out, and when she contacted the Boardwalk Inn management the safe was found to be empty.

(October 10: Wednesday)

Motor Vehicle Theft: 5700 block of Palm Boulevard. The complainant, a representative from Wild Dunes, reported that unknown person(s) stole a golf cart from the Wild Dunes Reception Center.

(October 11: Thursday)

Petit Larceny: 3600 block of Palm Boulevard. A victim reported that unknown suspect(s) stole scrap metal from his front yard.

(October 14: Sunday)

Theft From Motor Vehicle: 100 block of Charleston Boulevard. A victim reported that unknown person(s) entered into his unlocked vehicle and stole his sunglasses, cell phone, and GPS from within the vehicle.

(October 17: Wednesday)

Harassment: 2200 block of Waterway Boulevard. Victim reported that her ex-boyfriend was leaving text messages to leave lizards in her house knowing that she has a phobia in regards to reptiles.

(October 18: Thursday)

Vandalism: 900 block of Ocean Boulevard. Victim reported unknown suspect(s) damaged three pink flamingos that were in the front yard of his residence.

Burglary: Grand Pavilion. Complaint advised that unknown suspect(s) stole eleven(11) pictures from the rental unit. The owners were the last persons in the unit and it was then cleaned by American Cleaning Services. The unit is rented through Resort Quest.

(October 20: Saturday)

Petit Larceny: 2400 block of Waterway Boulevard. Victim reported that unknown suspect(s) stole the ignition key from his boat and discharged is fire extinguisher while the vessel was moored at the end of his dock.

(October 21: Sunday)

Larceny of Bicycle: 2100 block of Palm Boulevard. Victim reported that unknown suspect(s) stole his unsecured Onix beach cruiser from the front of the listed location. Victim advised SER number is unknown.

(October 24: Wednesday)

Theft From A Motor Vehicle: 2800 block of Cameron Boulevard. A victim reported that unknown person(s) entered into her unsecured vehicle, which was parked in the driveway of her residence, and stole 2 GPS units.

(October 25: Thursday)

Burglary: Lagoon Villas. Three (3) paintings were reported as being stolen from the victims' rental unit.

Burglary/Stolen Vehicle: Morgan Place Drive. The victim reported that he received a call from the Charleston Police Department advising him that an acquaintance had been detained after wrecking the victim's boat. Thereafter, it was determined that the same subject, who did not have permission to enter the victim's residence, also did not have the victim's permission to possess his boat or vehicle. The victim's vehicle was located and processed at the Isle of Palms Police Department. The subject was arrested and charged accordingly.

(October 29: Monday)

Theft From A Motor Vehicle: 2200 block of Cameron Boulevard. The victim reported that unknown person(s) stole the outboard motor of his boat, which he had attached to the boat and parked in the yard of his residence.

(October 31: Wednesday)

Theft From A Motor Vehicle: 1300 block of Palm Boulevard. The victim reported that unknown person(s) entered into his unlocked vehicle and stole his wallet. Later, the victim discovered that the perpetrator attempted to use one of his credit cards.

Patrol

During the month of August 2012, Officers issued 19 Business Check notices to business owners/employees advising them that the business was found unsecure. There were 44 Victim of Crime forms completed.

On October 9, the Dispatch Center made the transition to the Charleston County Consolidated Dispatch CAD/Pro Q & A system. Training Officers from the Consolidated Dispatch Center were in house for approximately one week to provide additional training to IOPPD Telecommunication Officers.

Community Service:

During the month of October, there was one meeting of the "Neighborhood Block Meet & Greet" held, on October 18th. The meeting was aimed at residents on 39th, 40th and 41st Avenues, as well as those in the 3900-4000 blocks of Hartnett and Cameron Boulevards. The gathering took place in the vacant lot across from 4005 Hartnett Boulevard.

Officers begin going door to door two days prior to the scheduled event to hand out flyers with the program information. The event is also posted on the City of Isle of Palms website. We have received positive feedback from citizens that have attended the gatherings. Two more meetings are scheduled for November.

Community Service Officers attended 40 hours of Community Service and Crime Prevention training.

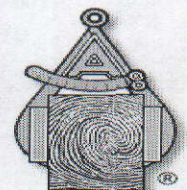
