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## Isle of Palms Fire Department

### Call Summary

February 2013

- 2/1/13 Personnel responded to a report of a small outside fire on Ocean Boulevard. Upon arrival the crew found a small area of pine straw that had been ignited by some discarded charcoal embers. The fire had been extinguished by the resident prior to the Fire Department's arrival. All units returned to service.
- 2/14/13 Personnel responded to the beach in the 1000 block of Ocean Boulevard after a caller reported seeing a warning flare in the sky over the water. Upon arrival personnel began checking the water from the shoreline and located an unknown object in the water. A watercraft was launched and personnel proceeded to the area where the object was seen. The object was determined to be a floating candle luminary. The area was checked thoroughly and no other contact was made. All units returned to service.
- 2/22/13 Personnel responded to a report of a possible structure fire on Dune Ridge Lane. Upon arrival personnel found no signs of smoke or fire and began investigating. Crews entered the residence and found the bottom element of the stove arcing. Power was secured to the appliance and the homeowner was advised to have the units inspected prior to using it again. All units returned to service.
- 2/27/13 Personnel responded to a report of a possible structure fire on Palm Boulevard. Upon arrival personnel found no signs of smoke or fire and began investigating. The crew met with the resident who said they were inside the home, looked outside and saw the gas grill on the back porch on fire. The resident said they shut off the gas to the grill and the fire went, but there was damage to the grill and its controls. After ensuring the situation was safe, all units returned to service.

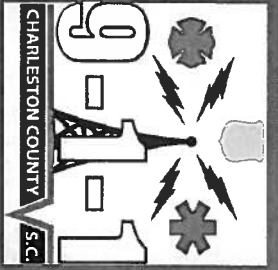
