# Isle of Palms Fire Department Call Summary March 2013

3/7/13	Personnel responded to Awendaw Fire Department Station No. 5 to stand by while they were on scene at a structure fire on Toby Road. The crew did not respond to any incidents and returned to service after being released by Awendaw personnel.
3/9/13	Personnel responded with Boat 1020 to Pinckney's Point in McClellanville to assist with the rescue of three stranded boaters. Boat 1020 was canceled during their response and returned to the station.
3/21/13	Personnel responded with Boat 1020 to Shem Creek to assist with the rescue of several stranded boaters. Boat 1020 was canceled during their response and returned to the station.
3/24/13	Personnel responded to a residence on Ocean Boulevard for a report of a gas leak. Upon arrival personnel met with the occupants who said they smelled gas around the swimming pool. All areas were checked using a gas detection meter and no abnormal readings were recorded. The gas service to the pool's heater was shut off as a precautionary measure and the occupant was advised to contact the property manager to have the unit inspected. All units returned to service.
3/31/13	Personnel responded to Breach Inlet for a report of a dog in the water that appeared to be in distress. Upon arrival crews found a dog that was struggling to get to shore and a watercraft was launched. Crews quickly rescued the dog from the water and returned him to shore where he was reunited with his owner. All units returned to service.
3/31/13	Personnel responded to a residence on Lagoon Road for a report of smoke in the building. Upon arrival crews found a strong burning odor in the building, but no smoke. After checking the building it was determined the air conditioning unit had malfunctioned and was the cause of the smoke. Wild Dunes maintenance officials arrived on scene and were initiating repairs as crews returned to service.

#### Additional Training

All career personnel received training on engine and ladder response protocol, rapid intervention, and leadership.

Medical in-service training covered Shock, Medical Overview, Cardiovascular Emergencies, Endocrine Emergencies, and Hematological Emergencies.

All volunteer personnel received training on equipment familiarization and they participated in a drill with the volunteers of the Mount Pleasant Fire Department on their mobile air unit.

Chief Graham attended the 2013 National Hurricane Conference in New Orleans. This annual event works to improve hurricane preparedness, response, recovery and mitigation. The conference serves as a national forum for officials to exchange ideas and recommend new policies to improve emergency management.

Battalion Chief Maibach conducted the first day of orientation for the recruits of the Charleston Area Joint Recruit School. Battalion Chief Maibach also is serving as the Coordinator for this program. Isle of Palms Volunteer Firefighter Burley is one of 15 recruits beginning their 14-week program of training.

Battalion Chief Maibach was an assisting instructor for the S.C. Fire Academy's Fireground Simulation course being held at the City of Charleston Fire Department.
