The following is a synopsis of some of the activities of the Isle of Palms Police Department during the month of September, 2013.

September 01: Sunday

Vandalism: 5th Avenue. A victim reported that unknown suspect(s) shot a BB into a window of his residence, maliciously causing damage the window.

September 03: Tuesday

Burglary: Hidden Green Lane. A victim reported that unknown suspect(s) stole two skateboards from an unsecured garage area of the residence.

September 04: Wednesday

Petit Larceny: Grand Pavilion Boulevard. A victim reported that unknown suspect(s) stole her medication from her unsecured pursue.

September 05: Thursday

Traffic Offense/Driving Under Suspension: Palm Boulevard/Charleston Boulevard. An Officer conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle that was confirmed to be traveling at a higher rate of speed than that posted. During the roadside investigation, it was discovered that the driver's license of the operator of the vehicle was suspended for failing to pay two traffic fines.

September 06: Friday

Petit Larceny: Grand Pavilion Boulevard. The victim reported that unknown suspect(s) stole his wallet, which he had left unsecured in the manager's office.

Traffic Stop/Open Container: 3300 block of Palm Boulevard. An Officer conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle for an equipment violation. While speaking with the operator of the vehicle, the Officer observed a liquor bottle with an open seal, lying on the floor of the rear passenger side of the vehicle. Additionally, information was obtained from dispatch that the same subject

had three outstanding bench warrants for failure to pay traffic fines. The subject was charged accordingly.

Simple Assault: 31st Avenue. Officers were dispatched to a fight in progress at approximately 7:03 a. m. Upon arrival, Officers spoke with one of the parties involved in the physical altercation who advised that the other subject involved left the scene, however, would meet with Officers on 28th Avenue. Conflicting accounts of the incident involving a child's bicycle were provided by both subjects, neither of whom wished to pursue charges.

September 07: Saturday

Vandalism: 9th Avenue. The victim advised reporting Officers that a subject, possibly known by the victim, vandalized his vehicle by puncturing one of the tires.

Vandalism: 28th Avenue. The complainant reported that unknown subjects damaged the baseball diamonds by driving a vehicle on fields.

September 08: Sunday

Petit Larceny: 3400 block of Hartnett Boulevard. The victim reported that an acquaintance stole his prescription medication from within his residence while visiting.

September 09: Monday

Traffic Offense/Driving Under Suspension: 1400 block of Palm Boulevard. An Officer conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle for a moving traffic violation. During the roadside investigation, the Officer was provided information that the driver's license of the operator of the vehicle was suspended, and that the same subject had two outstanding bench warrants for failure to pay traffic fines. The subject was placed under arrest and charged accordingly.

September 11: Wednesday

Theft From Vehicle: 25th Avenue. A victim reported that unknown suspect(s) stole the license plate from her vehicle, which was parked in her front yard at the time of the incident.

September 17: Tuesday

Traffic Offense/Warrant Arrest: 2300 block of Cameron Boulevard. An Officer conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle for an equipment violation. The roadside investigation revealed that the operator had an outstanding warrant originating from the U. S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement Agency (ICE). The subject was detained and turned over to an ICE Agent.

September 19: Thursday

Traffic Offense/Driving Under Suspension: 41st Avenue. An Officer conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle for a moving violation. During the roadside investigation, information was obtained that confirmed the driver's license of the operator of the vehicle as being suspended. The subject was also charged with failure to register his vehicle.

September 20: Friday

Vandalism: 1300 block of Ocean Boulevard. Officers arrested an intoxicated subject who had damaged a vehicle by kicking a side mirror off of the vehicle, while in the front beach area of Ocean Boulevard.

Theft From Vehicle: 100 block of Charleston Boulevard. The victim reported that unknown suspect(s) entered into her unsecured vehicle and stole an I-Phone and two chargers.

Petit Larceny: 1500 block of Palm Boulevard. The victim reported that unknown suspect(s) stole his child's bicycle, which had been left unsecured.

Theft From Vehicle: 2500 block of Waterway Boulevard. The victim reported that unknown subjects stole the license plate from his vehicle, while it was parked in his drive.

September 21: Saturday

Theft From Vehicle: 3800 block of Palm Boulevard. A victim reported that unknown suspect(s) stole loose change and an -pod, from his unsecured vehicle.

Theft From Vehicle: 200 block of Forest Trail. The victim reported that unknown suspect(s) entered into her unsecured vehicle and stole credit cards, gift cards and items containing her personal identification.

Traffic Offense/Driving Under Suspension: 1000 block of Palm Boulevard. An Officer conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle for an equipment violation. The roadside investigation revealed that the operator of the vehicle's license was suspended, and the same subject had an outstanding bench warrant for failure to pay a traffic fine.

September 22: Sunday

Public Intoxication/Warrant Arrest: 1000 block of Ocean Boulevard. An Officer conducting patrol of the front beach area observed a male subject that appeared to be intoxicated. After positively identifying the subject, an outstanding warrant originating from the Charleston County Sheriff's Office was confirmed. The subject was detained and transported to the Charleston County Detention Center.

September 23: Monday

Burglary: 1400 block of Ocean Boulevard. The victim reported that a cleaning crew had removed her personal property, in error, from her short term rental unit and took the property to the rental company office. When she reported to the office to retrieve her property, she discovered that her acoustic guitar was missing.

September 28: Saturday

Petit Larceny: 28th Avenue. The victim reported that unknown suspect(s) stole his cell-phone while he was playing basketball.

PATROL

During the month of September, Officers issued one Victim of Crime form and one Unsecured Business notification.

COMMUNITY SERVICES/CRIME PREVENTION SERVICES

PROPERTY IDENTIFICATION PROGRAM:

During the month of September, weekly follow-ups with all eight (8) involved rental companies continued to collect documented property identification information, to be entered into the departments Records Management System (RMS). Over 1,000 property identification tags have been distributed for marking and identifying property. Information for approximately 200 pieces of property has been gathered. Personnel from the real estate companies have advised that the opportunity to have time to collect additional information should increase since the busiest part of the season is nearing. Police Department personnel, as well as employees with the rental companies are looking forward to the off-season which will allow more time for documenting properties. The original goal of the program was to meet with a minimum of three (3) real estate companies and get a minimum of six (6) properties involved in the program. As of date, the annual goal for this program has been exceeded.

NEIGHBORHOOD MEET & GREET PROGRAM: During the month of September, there was one (1) Meet & Greet event held, as follows:

(MEET & GREET #8: 09/26/13)

Meeting Location: Parking lot of the Citadel Beach House 4700 Palm Boulevard)

Target Areas: Residents in the 4100-5700 blocks of Palm Boulevard, to include 42nd Avenue through 57th Avenue.

There were approximately eight (8) citizens in attendance. The event was posted on the City website and flyers were distributed throughout the neighborhood beginning 09/12/13 by patrol. Two (2) of the eight (8) in attendance, are new homeowners on the Isle of Palms. We received positive feedback for having programs such as the Meet & Greets and Crime Prevention Through Environmental Design (CPTED). No complaints were received. There was a citizen request to have photographs of Police Department personnel available on the City's website. The citizen making this request stated that he had seen this service provided on a number of different law enforcement agencies websites and thought it a good idea for citizens to have access to in order to better know our Officers. The next meeting is scheduled for October 25, 2013. The annual goal for 2013 was to hold a minimum of three (3) meetings for the year. As of date, this goal has been exceeded, as this was the eighth meeting.

An Officer played the Great Highland Bagpipe for the Coastal Carolina Shields September 11th. Memorial Ceremony at the Hall of Heroes, Sands Ocean Club, 201 75th Avenue North, Myrtle Beach, SC.
