**Call Summary**  
*November 2014*

- 11/5/14 Personnel responded to a residence on Hartnett Boulevard to assist with water removal due to an overflowing washing machine. Upon arrival crews utilized the "wet vac" to remove some water from the floors and carpeting. The homeowner was advised to contact a contractor to assist with other damage due to the water and all units returned to service.
- 11/10/14 Personnel responded to a report of a structure fire at the Veterans of Foreign Wars post on Ocean Boulevard. Crews were advised that the fire was due to a gas grill on the back porch. Upon arrival crews moved the grill and extinguished a fire that involved some of the wooden railing on the porch. No further fire extension was found, the grill was shut off, and the area secured. All units returned to service.
- 11/24/14 Personnel responded to the beach in the area of 49<sup>th</sup> Avenue to assist the South Carolina Department of Natural Resources with a dead marine animal. Upon arrival the crew met with a representative from the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration to assist with relocating a dead dolphin to a safe area where an autopsy could be conducted. When the autopsy was complete personnel assisted with loading the dolphin into a pickup truck from Isle of Palms Animal Control so it could be taken to another area on the beach for burial. All units returned to service.
- 11/30/14 Personnel responded to a report of a structure fire on Merritt Boulevard. Neighbors reported seeing smoke coming from the house. Upon arrival crews met with the homeowner's brother who said the fire had been extinguished. A pan of grease had been left on the stove and started to burn generating a large amount of smoke. Crews began to investigate and found damage to the surrounding kitchen cabinets and extension into the attic. Power to the affected areas was secured and crews began overhaul. The underside of the roof decking had been damaged by heat from the hood vent pipe, which caused a smoldering fire in the attic. All areas were wet down and the section roof was removed. The roof was covered to prevent further damage and all units returned to service.

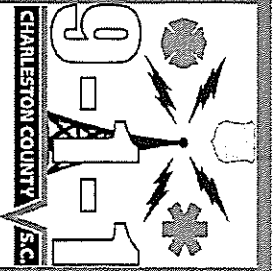

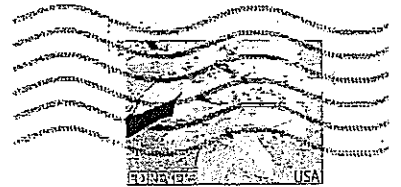

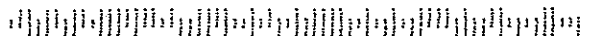
