Date: October 1, 2014

The following is a synopsis of some of the activities of the Isle of Palms Police Department during the month of September 2014.

September 1, 2014 – Monday

Narcotics Violation – Palm Boulevard / 13th Avenue

An Officer stopped a vehicle for an expired vehicle license. The Officer determined that driver had a suspended driver's license, was unlawfully possessing narcotics and was arrested and charged. Further investigation revealed that the vehicle and driver matched the description of being involved with several burglaries within the City of Isle of Palms. CID was notified and was able to establish that the driver had been involved with previous burglaries. These charges were also added to the subject.

September 2, 2014 – Tuesday

Indecent Exposure / Assault – Beach / 23rd Avenue

The victim reported that an unknown male subject was on the beach, where he exposed himself and ejaculated on her and the towel she was laying on. Officers were unable to locate the subject. This case has been assigned to CID for further investigation.

Indecent Exposure – Beach / 7th Avenue

The victim reported that they observed an unknown male subject masturbating while sitting under a canopy on the beach. Officers were unable to locate the subject. This case has been assigned to CID for further investigation.

September 4, 2014 – Thursday

Criminal Domestic Violence – 9500 Block Palmetto Drive

Officers responded to a 911 hang-up call and discovered that the husband had been physically assaulted by his wife. The female subject was arrested and charged.

September 6, 2014 – Saturday

Petit Larceny – 100 Block Palm Boulevard

The victim reported that unknown person(s) had removed a seat cushion from the bow of his boat. This case has been assigned to CID for further investigation.

Driving Under the Influence – Palm Boulevard / 34th Avenue

An Officer stopped a vehicle for multiple moving violations and further investigation revealed that the driver was possibly under the influence of alcohol. The Officer conducted Standardized Field Sobriety Testing with the driver, who was subsequently arrested and taken for Datamaster Testing, which resulted in a BAC of .16%. The driver was charged and lodged in the Detention Center.

September 7, 2014 – Sunday

Burglary – Fairway Village Lane

The victim reported that unknown person(s) had broken into their enclosed garage and stole a bicycle. This case has been assigned to CID for further investigation.

September 9, 2014 – Tuesday

Theft of Motor Vehicle Parts – 30th Avenue

The victim reported that an unknown person(s) had broken off the front emblem from his vehicle. This case has been assigned to CID for further investigation.

September 11, 2014 – Thursday

Narcotics Violation – Isle of Palms Connector

An Officer stopped a vehicle for speeding and further investigation revealed that the driver's license was suspended. During the pre-tow inventory of the vehicle, the Officer discovered the underage driver to be in possession of several mini bottles of liquor, marijuana, and drug paraphernalia. The driver was charged and lodged in the Detention Center.

Burglary – 9000 Block Palmetto Drive

The victim reported that when she and her family left to go to the swimming pool, unknown person(s) entered the residence where they were staying and stole cash from her purse. This case has been assigned to CID for further investigation.

Narcotics Violation – 1300 Block Ocean Boulevard

An Officer patrolling the Front Beach area observed a male subject to be passed out and slumped over the steering wheel. The Officer made contact with the subject to determine his well-being and saw drug paraphernalia sitting on the center console. Further investigation revealed the subject was in possession of cocaine, was arrested and lodged at the Detention Center.

September 13, 2014 – Saturday

Vandalism – 3600 Block Waterway Boulevard

The victim reported that unknown person(s) drove a golf cart through her fence causing significant damage. This case has been assigned to CID for further investigation.

September 16, 2014 – Tuesday

Driving Under the Influence – Palm Boulevard / 6th Avenue

An Officer stopped a vehicle for speeding and during contact with the driver, suspected that the driver was under the influence of alcohol. The driver admitted to consuming two glasses of wine earlier. The Officer conducted Standardized Field Sobriety Testing with the driver, who was subsequently arrested and taken for Datamaster testing, which resulted in a BAC of .13%. The driver was charged and lodged in the Detention Center.

September 17, 2014 – Wednesday

Vandalism – Beach / Sea Cabins

The victim reported that unknown person(s) had caused several dents on the front hood of his vehicle. This case has been assigned to CID for further investigation.

September 18, 2014 – Thursday

Motor Vehicle Theft – Sand Dollar Drive

The victim reported that unknown person(s) had taken their golf cart, but returned it, with noticeable damage to the seats and dents in various places on the cart. This case has been assigned to CID for further investigation.

September 19, 2014 – Friday

Open Container in Vehicle – 41st Avenue

An Officer observed a golf cart occupied with several subjects in possession of glass beer bottles. The Officer stopped the golf cart as the occupants attempted to hide the beer bottles. The subjects were each charged.

Open Container in Vehicle – Palm Boulevard / 13th Avenue

An Officer conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle for an equipment violation. Further investigation revealed that the passenger in the vehicle was in possession of an open can of beer and was charged.

September 20, 2014 – Saturday

Liquor Law Violations / Littering – 1000 Block Ocean Boulevard

An Officer observed a subject walking on the sidewalk carrying an open can of beer. As the Officer made contact with the subject, he threw the beer can into the bushes. The subject was charged.

Disorderly Conduct – 1000 Block Ocean Boulevard

An Officer observed a subject standing on the sidewalk and urinating into the street. The subject was arrested and lodged into the Detention Center.

Disorderly Conduct – 1000 Block Ocean Boulevard

An Officer observed a subject lying on the ground in front of a local establishment, unconscious in a pool of beer coming from an open can lying next to him. The subject was charged.

September 21, 2014 – Sunday

Disorderly Conduct – 900 Block Ocean Boulevard

An Officer observed a subject walking in the roadway carrying a clear plastic cup containing beer. The subject became agitated and belligerent as the Officer was trying to speak with him. The subject was arrested and lodged in the Detention Center.

Petit Larceny – Morgan Place Drive

The victim reported that unknown person(s) had stolen a kayak and two oars from his dock. This case was assigned to CID for further investigation.

Petit Larceny – Beach / 24th Avenue

The victim reported that unknown person(s) had removed his Kindle and car keys from his bag that had been left on the beach while he was walking. The keys had been left on top of a post at the beginning of the beach access path. This case was assigned to CID for further investigation.

September 23, 2014 – Tuesday

Narcotics Violation – Beach / 42nd Avenue

An Officer was patrolling the beach when several subjects were located lying on a blanket at night. Further investigation revealed that the subjects were in possession of drug paraphernalia, which was in plain view on the blanket. The Officer also discovered the subjects to be in possession of marijuana. All were charged.

Driving Under the Influence – 1500 Block Palm Boulevard

An Officer stopped a vehicle for a moving violation and upon contact with the driver suspected that he was under the influence of alcohol. The subject indicated he had only drunk two liquor drinks. The Officer conducted Standardized Field Sobriety Test, which resulted in the subject being arrested and taken for Datamaster Testing, where he refused to complete the testing. The subject was charged and lodged in the Detention Center.

September 24, 2014 – Wednesday

Identity Theft – Forest Trail

The victim reported that unknown person(s) had unlawfully obtained his personal information and opened a business in another state and he received a notice from the IRS advising he was taxes were delinquent. This case has been assigned to CID for further investigation.

September 25, 2014 – Thursday

Driving Under the Influence – IOP Connector

An Officer stopped a vehicle for a moving violation and suspected that the driver was under the influence of alcohol. The driver stated that he had only one glass of wine and after completing Standardized Field Sobriety Testing was arrested and taken for Datamaster Testing, which he refused to complete. The subject was charged and lodged in the Detention Center.

September 28, 2014 – Sunday

Stolen Property Offenses – 21st Avenue

An Officer stopped a vehicle for speeding and during the initial contact with the driver and passenger, smelled marijuana. Further investigation revealed that the subjects were in possession of marijuana and in possession of a stolen pistol from a local jurisdiction. During the inventory of the vehicle, a credit card belonging to a resident was located and confirmed to have been stolen. The subjects were arrested and lodged in the Detention Center.

Burglary – 9000 Palmetto Drive

The victim reported that unknown person(s) had stolen several items from inside their locked storage room. This case has been assigned to CID for further investigation.

September 29, 2014 – Monday

Driving Under the Influence – 1100 Block Ocean Boulevard

An Officer observed a golf cart driving on the sidewalk after dark and conducted a traffic stop. The Officer determined that the driver was suspected to be under the influence of alcohol and admitted to drinking three or four beers. The Officer conducted Standardized Field Sobriety Test and the driver was arrested and taken for Datamaster Testing, which he refused. The driver was charged and lodged in the Detention Center.

September 30, 2014 – Tuesday

Narcotics Violation – IOP Connector / Palm Boulevard

An Officer stopped a vehicle for an equipment violation. Further investigation revealed that the driver had an open container of liquor and marijuana in his possession. The driver was arrested and lodged in the Detention Center.

Community Service

Department personnel held a “Coffee with a Cop” meeting at Harris Teeter on Wednesday, September 10, 2014. Turnout for this event was successful, with approximately thirty to forty residents and visitors that discussed issues and concerns. This was the third meeting this summer by the Police Department as a part of the Department’s new or improved service plan for the calendar year 2014.

During the month of August 2014, Officers issued eighteen (18) “You Could Have Been a Victim of a Crime” notices and one hundred sixty-five (165) Property Security Check notices.

During the month of September 2014, the Consolidated Dispatch Center received and dispatched 4761 calls for service to the four (4) public safety agencies of Isle of Palms and Sullivan's Island, and the National Park Service. The following is a breakdown of activity by department.
