## Isle of Palms Fire Department

### Call Summary

February 2015

- 2/12/2015 Personnel responded to a report of two boaters stranded on Caper's Island. Boat 1020 was launched and arrived to find two people who had docked at Caper's Island to fish, and returned to find their boat had sunk. Both individuals were provided transportation back to the Isle of Palms Marina on Boat 1020. The owner stated he would return to the area tomorrow to retrieve the boat. This information was passed on to the U.S. Coast Guard. No further assistance was needed.
- 2/16/2015 Personnel responded to a report of a motor vehicle accident in the 300 block of Palm Boulevard. Upon arrival they found one vehicle had struck a palm tree and the driver was entrapped in the vehicle. The crew used hydraulic rescue tools to remove the driver's side and displace the steering column. Personnel packaged the patient, removed them from the vehicle, and turned patient care over to Charleston County EMS.
- 2/25/2015 Personnel responded to a confirmed structure fire on Sullivan's Island. Immediately after dispatch, Chief 1201 confirmed it was a working fire, and requested an engine and a ladder truck from Isle of Palms to respond. Crews arrived on scene and immediately went to work to help contained the fire. After about 20 minutes the fire was brought under control and crews began the overhaul process. Rescue 1001 also responded to the scene to refill SCBA cylinders for personnel from Isle of Palms, Sullivan's Island, and Mount Pleasant. Crews assisted with picking up hose and then were released by command. All units were back in service.

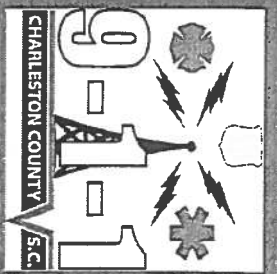

All career personnel participated in their annual live burn refresher, and trained on the Department's response protocol.

Medical in-service training covered annual CPR refresher training.

Chief Ann Graham attended a seminar conducted by the Municipal Association of South Carolina at the Mount Pleasant Fire Department headquarters addressing the National Fire Protection Association Standard 1500 – Occupational Safety and Health. Curt Varone, an attorney, explained the ramifications of the updated standard and provided participants with a self-audit document to take back to their departments.

Battalion Chief Bob Maibach and Captain Roger Eagle completed the Instructor Orientation Workshop for the National Fire Academy's Intermediate and Advanced Incident Command System courses. This course was held in conjunction with the S.C. Fire Academy.

All supervisory personnel in the Department completed the annual Alcohol and Drug Awareness/Sexual Harassment training.
