Call Summary

March 2015

- 3/10/15 Personnel responded to the area of Goat Island for a report of a helicopter in distress. Upon arrival personnel quickly established visual contact with the helicopter and determined it was not in distress. Personnel remained on scene until the helicopter continued north along the Intracoastal Waterway.
- 3/17/15 Personnel responded to the beach in the area of the 4th Avenue beach access for a report of a watercraft in distress. A caller reported seeing a flare being shot off and called the Fire Department. The U.S. Coast Guard was notified and they began to assist with the search. After some time, Coast Guard personnel reported seeing a meteor shower. It was decided by all agencies to suspend the search. Coast Guard personnel conducted a first light search and found nothing.
- 3/21/15 Fire and police personnel responded to a residence on 24th Avenue for a report of a person shot. Once the scene was secured by law enforcement, fire department personnel arrived and initiated patient care along with Charleston County EMS. After a short time, the patient was packaged and loaded for transport to the Medical University of South Carolina. Two firefighters continued to assist the EMS crew with transport and treatment. The patient did succumb to their injuries.
- 3/22/15 Personnel responded to the area of Palm Boulevard and 9th Avenue for a report of a motor vehicle accident involving an Isle of Palms Police Department vehicle. Upon arrival crews found a two-vehicle accident with both vehicles sustaining significant damage. Two patients were assessed for injuries, but both declined further treatment and transport by EMS. All units stood by until both vehicle had been removed from the road.

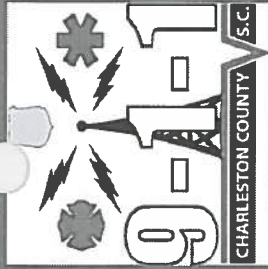

On February 25, 2015, Sullivan's Island experienced a structure fire at 2414 Jasper Boulevard. The Fire Department was dispatched at 7:30 a.m. and upon arrival found the residence fully engulfed. Chief Stith immediately called for assistance from Isle of Palms and Mt. Pleasant.
