Isle of Palms Fire Department

Call Summary

August 2017

- 8/2/17 Personnel responded to a call for an accident involving two jet skis in the Intracoastal Waterway at Dewees Inlet. Upon arrival, fire crews met with a boat crew from Tidal Wave who brought both patients back to the Tidal Wave docks. Both patients were assessed and treated according to their injuries. Once patient care was transferred to Charleston County EMS, all crews returned back to service.
- 8/3/17 Personnel responded to a structure fire in Charleston near the Wando River. Upon arrival, fire crew set up a portable water pump to assist with water supply. Once the fire was extinguished, all personnel were released from the scene and returned back to service.
- 8/5/17 Personnel responded to a report of an automobile accident in the area of Seagrass Lane and Backbay Drive. While en-route, fire crews were notified that this call was in reference to an automobile that had struck a pedestrian. Upon arrival, fire crews found one patient who was conscious and alert with what appeared to be only minor injuries. The patient complained of pain on their left side and had some "road rash" on the left side of their back. The patient was assessed and patient care was transferred to Charleston County EMS. All units returned back to service.
- 8/6/17 Personnel responded to a boat that had run aground which was occupied by one woman and her two year old child. It was reported that the boat was in the area of Capers Inlet. Fire crews responded in Boat 1020 and began a search for the disabled vessel. Fire crews searched the area of Capers Inlet with no results. Boat 1020 then left Capers Inlet and into open water where they noticed a light being waved from Dewees Island. The crew of Boat 1020 went to where they saw the signal and made contact confirming that they were indeed the complainant. All parties boarded boat 1020 and returned back to the Isle of Palms Marina. There was no further need from the fire department. All units returned back to service.
- 8/10/17 Personnel responded to a report of a structure fire at the Sea cabins Villas. Upon arrival crews began investigating and discovered a light switch in the wall that had shorted out. Smoke was emitting from the wall plate. Power to the switch was secured. The wall plate and switch was removed and the wires were capped off with wire nuts. The occupant of the residence was notified to have an electrician make the necessary repairs before power was secured. All units cleared from the scene and returned back to service.

- 8/11/17 Personnel responded to the area of the beach behind Coconut Joe's for a possible drowning. While en-route, fire personnel were informed that CPR had been started by Isle of Palms Police Department personnel. Upon arrival, fire crews found the patient laying near the tide line with a police officer actively doing CPR. Fire department personnel took over CPR and applied the automatic external defibrillator to the patient. Charleston County EMS arrived on scene, assumed patient care, and transported the patient to the hospital. All fire personnel cleared from the scene and returned back to service.
- 8/19/17 Personnel responded to the Isle of Palms Marina on 41st Avenue for a call of a fuel leak. Upon arrival fire crews found an automobile that was leaking fuel from the fuel tank. It was found that one of the valets backed a patron's vehicle over a piece of rebar which punctured the fuel tank. It was estimated that the vehicle leaked approximately five to ten gallons of fuel onto the ground. Fire crews covered the spill with absorbent. All necessary notifications were made in regards to the environmental impact of the spill. All fire personnel cleared from the scene and returned back to service.

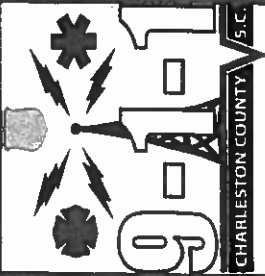
