**Call Summary**  
*February 2017*

- 2/5/2017 Personnel responded to a structure fire in Mount Pleasant. Rescue 1001 was requested to provide breathing air support at a working structure fire. Upon arrival Rescue 1001's crew assisted with filling air cylinders. Once complete, Rescue 1001 was released and returned to quarters.
- 2/22/2017 Personnel responded to investigate a report of three storage tanks that had washed onto the beach behind Ocean Point. Upon arrival the crew secured a perimeter around the tanks and notified the U.S. Coast Guard. Coast Guard said they were aware of the situation, and they had the owner's name and contact information. The owner was contact and the Fire Department coordinated the removal of the tanks from the beach.
- 2/26/2017 Personnel responded to a structure fire in Mount Pleasant. Rescue 1001 was requested to provide breathing air support at a working structure fire. Upon arrival Rescue 1001's crew assisted with filling air cylinders. Once complete, Rescue 1001 was released and returned to quarters.
- 2/27/2017 Personnel responded to a report of gas leak at a home on Palm Boulevard. Upon arrival the resident told the crews that the gas odor was detectable underneath the home. Personnel made entry under the house and found a broken low pressure gas pipe that was leaking. Personnel secured the flow of gas by closing the valve for the underground storage tank and ventilated the area. A gas meter was used to evaluate the area and all readings were within acceptable limits. The resident was told to contact the gas company to make the necessary repairs. All units returned to service.

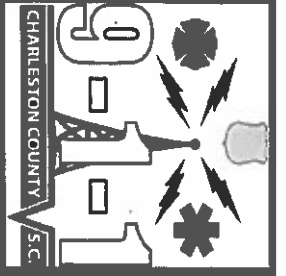
