Call Summary
May 2018

- 5/5/2018 Fire personnel responded to a report of an outside fire near Waterway Boulevard. Upon arrival, crews found a small brush fire near the golf course which was not threatening any structures. The fire was extinguished and the area was checked for any other fire extensions. It is unknown what caused the fire. All personnel cleared from the scene and returned back to service.
- 5/21/2018 Fire personnel responded to a report on an animal bite on the beach at 30th Avenue. The call had originally been dispatched to Sullivan's Island with the address being on the beach at Station 30. Sullivan's Island informed Charleston County Dispatch that there was no call found at the location originally dispatched. That is when the Isle of Palms Fire Department was dispatched to the beach at 30th Avenue. While en-route, Charleston County EMS notified fire crews that they had already loaded the patient and was beginning the transport to a local hospital. All Isle of Palms Fire personnel were cancelled from the call and returned back to service.
- 5/25/2018 Fire personnel responded to a report of a boat taking on water at Capers Island. A crew of three personnel responded in Boat 1020 and found the vessel in distress on the shoreline of Capers Island. Upon arrival, the individuals on the vessel stated that they were able to get the bilge pump working and were ok at that time. Once the water had been pumped out, the individuals on the boat left Capers Island and returned back to the Isle of Palms Marina. All fire personnel cleared from the scene and returned back to service.
- 5/26/2018 Fire personnel responded to a report of an auto accident on Jasper Boulevard on Sullivan's Island. Upon arrival, crews found a single vehicle that had struck a power pole. Isle of Palms Fire personnel assisted with the extrication of two victims as well as provide medical assistance. After the patients had been turned over to Charleston County EMS, fire crews remained on scene to provide lighting for the scene. All units cleared the scene after being released by Sullivan's Island and returned back to service.
- 5/26/2018 Fire personnel responded to a report of a fuel leak from a boat docked behind 41st Avenue. Upon arrival, crews found a vessel that had discharged approximately 3 gallons of fuel via bilge pump. The owner of the vessel stated that he must have "hit a valve" causing fuel to be released. The owner had secured the valve and stopped the fuel leak. The United States Coast Guard was informed of the incident. All units cleared from the scene and returned back to service.

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- 5/27/2018 Fire personnel responded to the Isle of Palms Connector for an auto accident involving three vehicles. One person involved was checked for injuries by Charleston County EMS. Fire crews assisted with clean-up and used oil-dry for the fluids that had leaked onto the connector. No persons involved complained of any injuries and no medical care was needed. All personnel cleared from the scene and returned back to service.
- 5/28/2018 Fire personnel responded to Morgan Place Drive for a smell of smoke in a residence. Crews were able to isolate the smell to electrical transformer in a control box for the home's elevator. The homeowner had already secured power to the control box and the excessive heat was dissipating. Fire personnel utilized a positive pressure ventilation fan in order to remove the smoke and smell from the residence. The occupants of the home were informed not to restore power to the unit until proper repairs could be made. All crews cleared from the scene and returned back to service.
- 5/28/2018 Fire personnel responded to the area of the Isle of Palms Recreation Center for a report of an explosion. Fire crews checked the Recreation Center but did not find any issues. After speaking with many by-standers, fire crews were told that witnesses saw someone launch a large firework mortar which had created the noise. There was nobody found shooting fireworks at that time. All crews cleared from the scene and returned back to service.

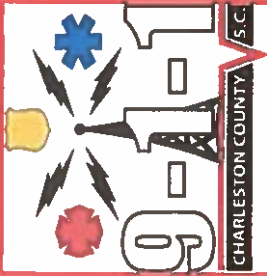

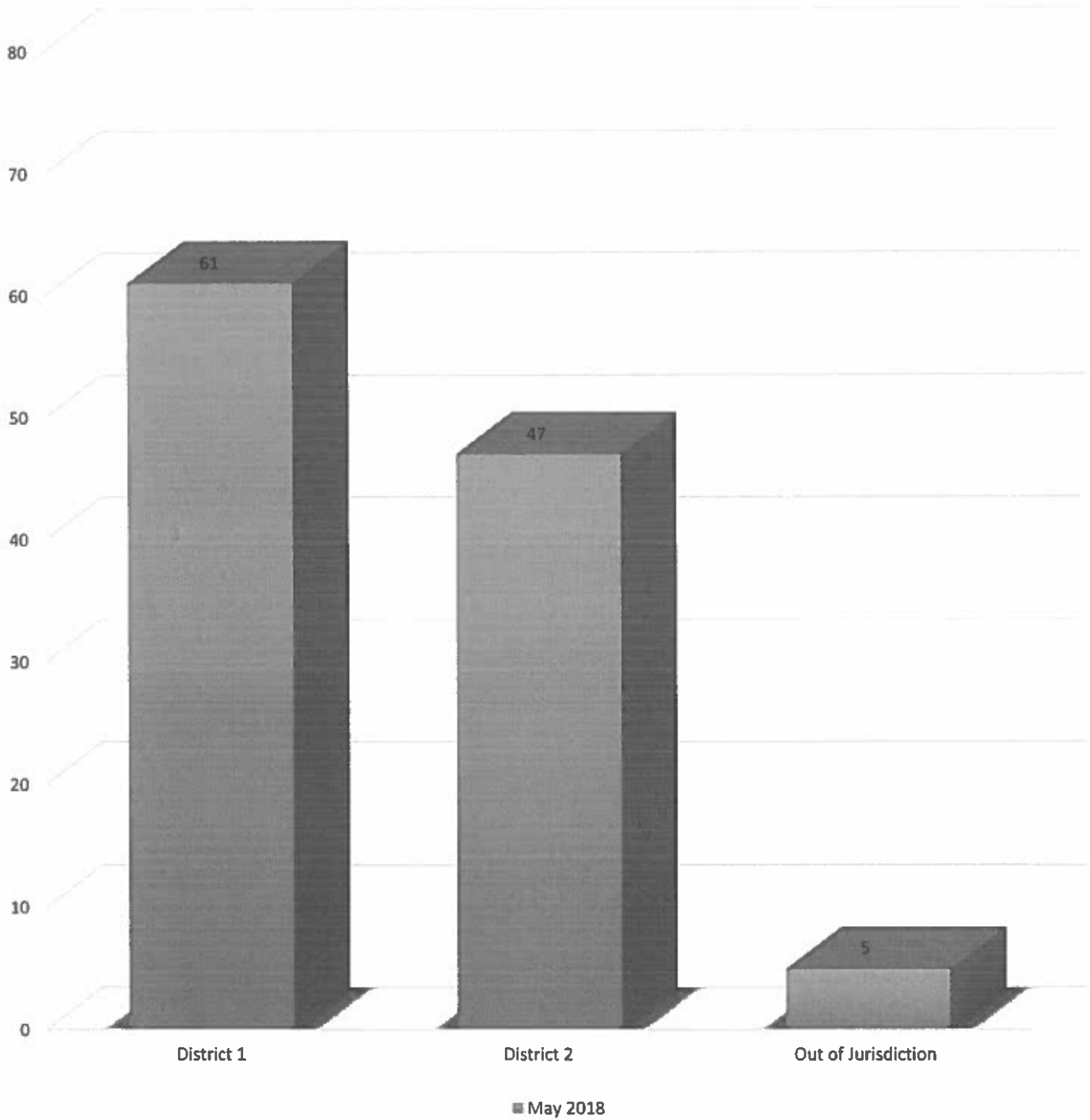
Calls per Day for May 2018
