Personnel responded to a report of an outside fire at a business on Ocean Boulevard. Upon arrival crews were directed to the rear of the business where they found a fire burning between two buildings. The area had limited access due to a privacy fence, so a ladder was put in place, and personnel climbed over the fence to extinguish the fire. Overhaul was completed and all units returned to service.

Personnel responded to a report of a structure fire at a residence on Waterway Boulevard. While enroute units were advised that there was sparking and burning inside an oven. Upon arrival the crew met with the homeowner and investigated the situation. The power was secured to the oven, and the sparking and burning stopped. After checking further personnel found the lower burner element in the oven had gone bad. The homeowner was advised to keep the power to the oven off until the burner element could be replaced. All units returned to service.

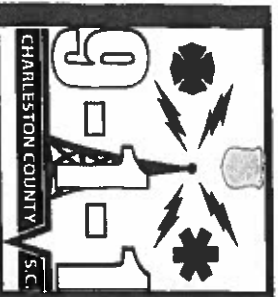
