Isle of Palms Fire Department Call Summary March 2016

3/3/16	Personnel responded to Dewees Creek for a report of five kayakers in distress. Boat 1020 was launched and proceeded to the area. The crew was able to rescue three of the kayakers, while the Department of Natural Resources and a passerby were able to assist the remaining kayakers. All kayakers and their equipment were safely returned to the Isle of Palms

3/4/16	Personnel responded to a report of a propane gas leak at a residence on

- 3/4/16 Personnel responded to a report of a propane gas leak at a residence on Hidden Green Lane. Upon arrival the crew used the gas meter to assess the area and found unsafe level of gas in the garage area. The crew ventilated the area and continued to monitor. The gas was secured at the propane cylinder and the gas company was notified.
- 3/15/16 Personnel responded to a report of a smell of electrical burning in a residence on Waterway Island Drive. Upon arrival the crew began investigating and found the odor coming from the entertainment center. Power was secured to all components of the entertainment center and the component that had been burning was removed from the building. Natural ventilation was done to clear the home. No further issues were noted.
- 3/18/16 Personnel responded to the Isle of Palms Connector to assist the Police Department with the recovery of evidence from the Intracoastal Waterway. Jet Ski 1002 was launched from the Isle of Palms Marina, but could not get close to the area to retrieve the evidence, so Charleston County Rescue Squad was requested to send their air boat to assist. Upon their arrival Fire Department personnel were taken to the area under the connector, the evidence was collected, and turned over to the Police Department.
- 3/24/16 Personnel responded to a report of a traumatic injury on 53rd Avenue. Upon arrival the crew found a construction worker had accidentally cut their arm with a circular saw. Personnel conducted an assessment of the injury and controlled bleeding with a tourniquet until the arrival of Charleston County EMS. The crew assisted with patient packaging and the patient was transported to a local hospital for further treatment.
