The following is a synopsis of some of the activities of the Isle of Palms Police Department during the month of December.

## Tuesday, December 6

### Fraud – 35<sup>th</sup> Avenue

A victim reported that an unknown subject had opened a credit card in her name without authorization and made several purchases. The approximate amount of items fraudulently purchased was \$138. This case was assigned to CID for further investigation.

## Wednesday, December 7

### Petit Larceny – 9000 Block Palmetto Drive

A victim reported that unknown person(s) had stolen her handgun, holster and ammunition, which had been packed for moving from one location to another by a moving company. The approximate value of the stolen items is \$600. The owner was able to provide a serial number and the gun was entered into NCIC. This case has been assigned to CID for further investigation.

## Saturday, December 10

### Vandalism – 100 Block Sparrow Drive

A victim reported that unknown persons drove across the front lawn of his residence and struck the cable box. The approximate value of the damage caused is \$75. This case has been assigned to CID for further investigation.

## Sunday, December 11

### Agency Assist – SIPD – Thompson Park Area of Sullivan's Island

An officer responded to a request for assistance from Sullivan's Island Police Department for a group of teenagers who had ingested illegal narcotics, specifically acid. EMS was called to the scene for transport of a subject that was having medical issues related to the narcotics.

Driving Under the Influence – IOP Connector

An officer conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle for speeding. The officer determined that the driver was possibly under the influence and when asked, indicated he drank four beers. When requested to perform Standardized Field Sobriety Tests, the driver initially refused, but changed his mind. The officer also located an open container of beer, which was located inside the vehicle. The driver was arrested and transported to the IOPPSB for Datamaster Testing, where he refused to provide a breath sample. The driver was transported to the AI Cannon Detention Center.

Open Container – 1400 Block of Palm Boulevard

An officer observed a collision occur and responded to investigate. During the investigation, the officer detected the odor of an alcoholic beverage and observed that the driver's clothes were wet. The officer located an open container of beer inside the vehicle. The driver was arrested and transported to the AI Cannon Detention Center.

Monday, December 12

Vandalism – 6000 Block Palmetto Drive

A victim reported that unknown persons had damaged the nets on the tennis courts by cutting the tension cable on the nets. The approximate amount of damaged caused is \$600. This case has been assigned to CID for further investigation.

Wednesday, December 14

Theft from Motor Vehicle – 2900 Block Waterway Boulevard

A victim reported that unknown persons entered into their unlocked vehicle and stole her purse containing personal documents, an iPhone charger, sunglasses and a laptop. The approximate value of the stolen items is \$1,950. This case has been assigned to CID for further investigation.

Theft from Motor Vehicle – 200 Block Forest Trail

A victim reported that unknown persons entered into their unlocked vehicle and stole dash mounted camera and personal documents. The approximate value of the stolen items is \$250. This case has been assigned to CID for further investigation.

Theft from Motor Vehicle – 4000 Block Waterway Boulevard

A victim reported that unknown persons entered into their unlocked vehicles and stole the owner's manuals and vehicle registration cards. The approximate value of the stolen items is \$50. This case has been assigned to CID for further investigation.

Disorderly Conduct – 1400 Block Palm Boulevard

An officer responded to a report of a suspicious person and upon arrival located a subject sleeping inside his car. The officer woke up the subject and further investigation revealed that he was intoxicated and had urinated on himself. The subject refused to cooperate with the officer and answer questions. The subject was arrested and transported to AI Cannon Detention Center.

## **Friday, December 16**

### **Driving Under the Influence** – Palm Boulevard / 24<sup>th</sup> Avenue

An officer responded to a report of a possible intoxicated driver and located the vehicle, stopping it for moving violations. Further investigation revealed that the driver was possibly under the influence. When asked, the driver indicated that he had not been drinking. The officer requested that the driver perform Standardized Field Sobriety Tests and upon conclusion of testing, was arrested. The driver was transported to the IOPPSB for Datamaster Testing and provided a breath sample with a 0% BAC. A Drug Recognition Expert was contacted to conduct further testing and determined that the driver was under the influence of CNS depressants and narcotic analgesics. The driver was transported to the Al Cannon Detention Center.

### **Theft from Motor Vehicle** – 100 Block Palm Boulevard

A victim reported that while at dinner, an unknown person entered into her vehicle, which had been valet parked and stole a necklace that were inside a bag in the back of the vehicle. The approximate value of the stolen item is \$200. This case has been assigned to CID for further investigation.

## **Monday, December 19**

### **Simple Possession of Marijuana** – Area of 31<sup>st</sup> Avenue

An officer observed a vehicle parked with the back driver's side sticking out into lane of travel. The officer located the owner of the vehicle on the beach and as he approached, smelled the odor of marijuana. Upon making contact with the owner of the vehicle, he attempted to hide the marijuana cigarette in his pocket. The subject was placed under arrest and transported to the Al Cannon Detention Center.

### **Theft from Motor Vehicle** – 9500 Block Palmetto Drive

A victim reported that unknown persons stole her bicycle that had been on the car mounted bicycle rack. The approximate value of the stolen item is \$200. This case has been assigned to CID for further investigation.

## **Tuesday, December 20**

### **Vandalism** – 800 Block Ocean Boulevard

A victim reported that unknown persons had entered onto a residential construction site and smeared some type of seafood juices on the glass, which stained the wood threshold at the door. The approximate amount of damaged caused is \$7,000. This case has been assigned to CID for further investigation.

## **Wednesday, December 21**

### **Petit Larceny** – 3200 Block Waterway Boulevard

A victim reported that unknown persons entered into her mailbox and stole several packages, leaving the paper and address label in the vacant lot across from her residence. The approximate value of items stolen is \$120. This case has been assigned to CID for further investigation.

**Petit Larceny** – 2600 Block Hartnett Boulevard

A victim reported that unknown persons entered into her mailbox and stole a package that had been delivered to her residence. The approximate value of the items stolen is \$25. This case has been assigned to CID for further investigation.

**Tuesday, December 27**

**Burglary** – 200 Block Ocean Boulevard

A victim reported that unknown persons broke into the owner's closet of his rental property and stole two televisions. The approximate value of the stolen items is \$3,000. This case has been assigned to CID for further investigation.

**Friday, December 30**

The property manager for a rental unit reported that the renter had taken without permission several electronic items from inside the residence. The approximate value of the items stolen is \$400. This case has been assigned to CID for further investigation.

**Saturday, December 31**

**Warrant Arrest** – IOP Connector

An officer stopped a vehicle for an expired vehicle license plate. Further investigation revealed that the driver had three outstanding arrest warrants for check fraud with Charleston County Sheriff's Office. The warrants were confirmed and the driver was arrested and transferred to a Deputy with Charleston County Sheriff's Office.
