The following is a synopsis of some of the activities of the Isle of Palms Police Department during the month of November.

Wednesday, November 2

Burglary - Beach Club Villas

A victim reported that unknown person(s) entered into his rental property and stole golf clubs and vacuum cleaner from a secured closet. The approximate value of the items stolen is \$1,200. This case was assigned to CID for further investigation.

Monday, November 7

Driving Under the Influence - IOP Connector

An officer stopped a vehicle for speeding, 76MPH in a posted 55MPH speed zone. Upon making contact with the driver, the officer determined that he was possibly under the influence. The officer requested the driver perform Standardized Field Sobriety Tests and upon completion, was placed under arrest. The driver was transported to IOPPSB for DMT Testing, where he refused to provide a sample. The driver was lodged in the Al Cannon Detention Center.

Tuesday, November 8

Traffic Offense - 3rd Avenue / Palm Boulevard

An officer stopped a vehicle for speeding, 49MPH in a posted 35MPH speed zone. Further investigation revealed that the driver did not possess a valid driver's license, did not have insurance on the vehicle and was in possession of marijuana. The driver was arrested and transported to the Al Cannon Detention Center.

Wednesday, November 9

Credit Card Fraud-41st Avenue

A victim reported that unknown person(s) had stolen her credit/debit card information and made several unauthorized purchases. The approximate amount charged is \$943. This case has been assigned to CID for further investigation.

Thursday, November 10

Vandalism - 5700 Block Palm Boulevard

A victim reported that unknown person(s) attempted to lift the gate arm to the rear entrance of Wild Dunes and broke the pin that holds the arm in place. The approximate amount of damage caused is valued at \$500. This case has been assigned to CID for further investigation.

Sunday, November 13

Motor Vehicle Theft - 22nd Avenue

A victim reported that unknown person(s) had stolen his unlocked vehicle from his driveway. The approximate value of the stolen vehicle is \$10,000. In addition, the victim also indicated that a credit card had been inside his vehicle and had been used in a neighboring jurisdiction. This case was assigned to CID for further investigation.

Petit Larceny - 1100 Block Ocean Boulevard

A victim reported that while eating at a local establishment she left her mobile phone behind. When the victim attempted to track the mobile phone, it was discovered that it was in a neighboring jurisdiction. The approximate value of the stolen phone is \$369. This case has been assigned to CID for further investigation.

Monday, November 14

Driving Under Suspension - IOP Connector

An officer stopped a vehicle for speeding, 73MPH in a posted 55MPH speed zone. Further investigation during the stop revealed that the driver's license was currently under suspension for the third offense. The driver was arrested and transported to the Al Cannon Detention Center.

Tuesday, November 15

Theft from Motor Vehicle - 31st Avenue

A victim reported that unknown person(s) entered into her unlocked vehicle and stole cash from inside the vehicle. The approximate amount stolen was \$20. This case has been assigned to CID for further investigation.

Friday, November 18

Driving Under Suspension - 41st Avenue

An officer conducting Selective Traffic Enforcement, due to a resident's complaint, stopped a vehicle for speeding, 34MPH in a posted 25MPH speed zone. Further investigation revealed that the driver's license was currently suspended for three previous offenses. In addition, the vehicle's license plate was suspended and the driver had three additional suspensions for failure to appear in court offenses. The driver was arrested and transported to the Al Cannon Detention Center.

Driving Under Suspension -41st Avenue

An officer conducting Selective Traffic Enforcement, due to a resident's complaint, stopped a vehicle for speeding, 32MPH in a posted 25MPH speed zone. Further investigation revealed that the driver's

license was currently suspended for two previous offenses. The driver was arrested and transported to the Al Cannon Detention Center.

Burglary - 300 Block Charleston Boulevard

A victim reported that when they arrived at their family's beach house they saw a vehicle in the driveway that they did not recognize. When they were walking up to the house, they saw two females they did not recognize run to the back of the house and moments later the two females and three male subjects all ran from the house, got into the vehicle and left. Officers determined that the subjects had entered into the residence without the owner's permission. This case has been assigned to CID for further investigation.

Theft from Motor Vehicle - 23rd Avenue

An officer received information that a resident may have had their vehicle license stolen. The officer made contact with the owner and confirmed that the vehicle license had been stolen from his vehicle. The vehicle license plate was entered into NCIC. This case has been assigned to CID for further investigation.

Traffic Offense - 500 Block Palm Boulevard

An officer stopped a vehicle for speeding, 47MPH in a posted 35MPH speed zone. Upon making contact with the driver, the officer determined that he was possibly under the influence. The officer requested the driver perform Standardized Field Sobriety Tests and upon completion, was placed under arrest. In addition, the driver was in possession of drug paraphernalia and his license was suspended for a previous DUI. The driver was transported to IOPPSB for DMT Testing, where he refused to provide a sample. The driver was lodged in the Al Cannon Detention Center.

Monday, November 21

Credit Card Fraud - 2400 Block Waterway Boulevard

A victim reported that a known person had used her credit card without permission. The suspect charged approximately \$2,600 at various stores and made on-line purchases. This case has been assigned to CID for further investigation.

Friday, November 25

<u>Traffic Offense / Warrant Arrest</u> – Palm Boulevard / 3rd Avenue

An officer stopped a vehicle for speeding, 45MPH in a posted 35MPH speed zone. Further investigation revealed that the driver had an active arrest warrant with Mount Pleasant Police Department for synthetic narcotics possession. The driver was arrested and transferred to the custody of MPPD.

Monday, November 28

Traffic Offense – 41st Avenue / Forest Trail

An officer conducting Selective Traffic Enforcement, due to a resident's complaint, stopped a vehicle for speeding, 39MPH in a posted 25MPH speed zone. Further investigation revealed that the driver did not possess a valid driver's license and had a previous arrest for the same. The driver was arrested and transported to the Al Cannon Detention Center.

Burglary - 23rd Avenue

A victim reported that subjects known to her attempted to forcibly enter into her residence to take back a television that had been given as a gift. Due to conflicting information, this case has been assigned to CID for further investigation.

Personnel Recognition

Command Staff recognizes the following personnel for their outstanding performance:

Captain Kim Usry, Accreditation Manager and Detective Sergeant Sharon Baldrick, Assistant Accreditation Manager for ensuring a successful On-Site with the Assessors from the Commission on Accreditation for Law Enforcement Agencies (CALEA). The CALEA Assessors visited the Department from November 28 – December 1 during which time they met personnel from the Police Department, City Government and Recreation Department. In addition, they met several citizens to learn how the Department performs and the opinions of the services.

Chief Buckhannon, Captain Usry and Det. Sgt. Baldrick will travel to Mobile, Alabama in March 2017 to attend the CALEA Hearing for the Department's potential to be re-accredited for the fifth time.

Community Service Activities

During the month of November 2016, Officers issued one hundred twenty-seven (127) "Property Security Check Notices" and seven (7) "You Could Have Been a Victim of a Crime" notices.

November 2 – Pfc. Louise Hardy, Pfc. James Taylor and Sergeant Meekins attended the Keenagers Meeting. The officers discussed awareness of potential frauds, how to avoid and report crimes. In addition, the officers ate lunch and assisted with bingo for the group.

November 2 – 5 – Detective Sergeant Sharon Baldrick assisted other local law enforcement agencies in hosting the 2016 CALEA Conference held in North Charleston.
