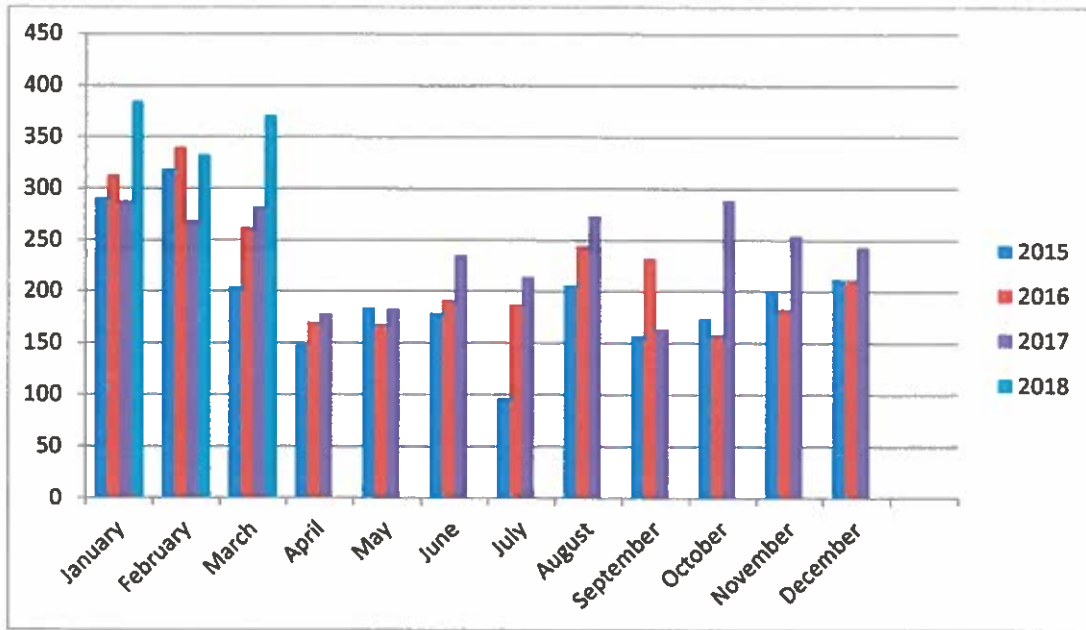

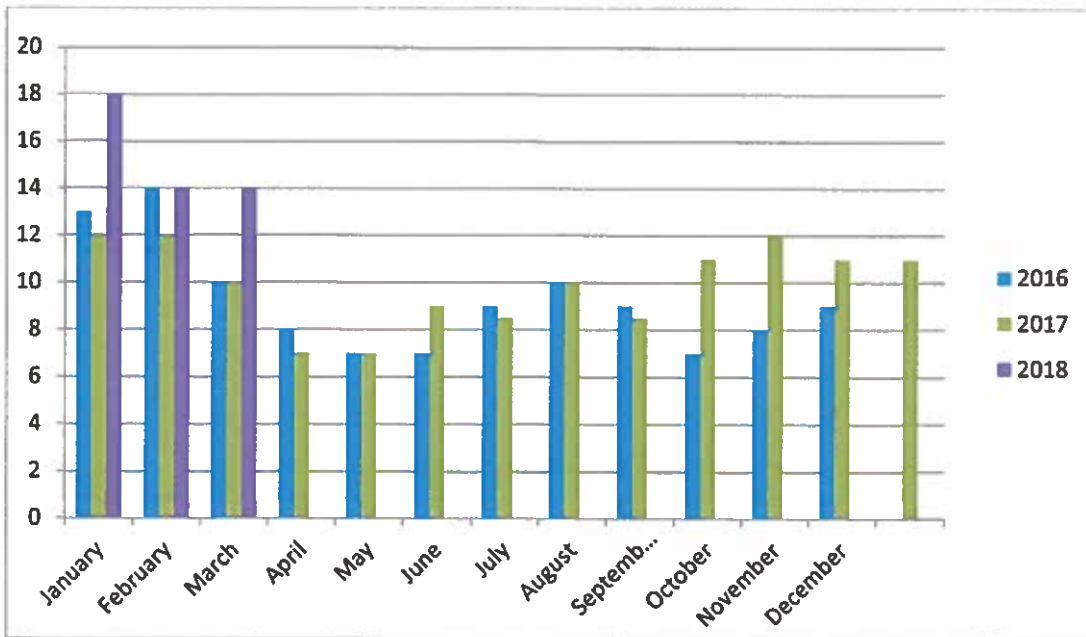

- Marked 15' circles around fire hydrants on Palm Boulevard.

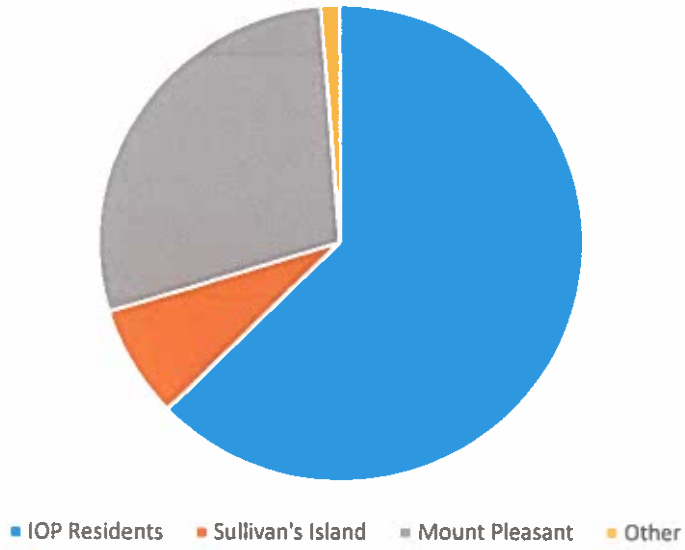
## Isle of Palms Recreation Cardio Room Usage



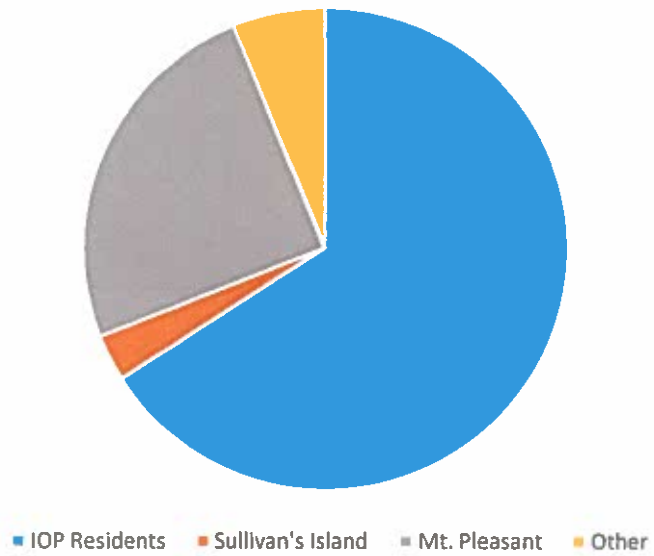
### CARDIO ROOM AVERAGE DAILY ATTENDANCE



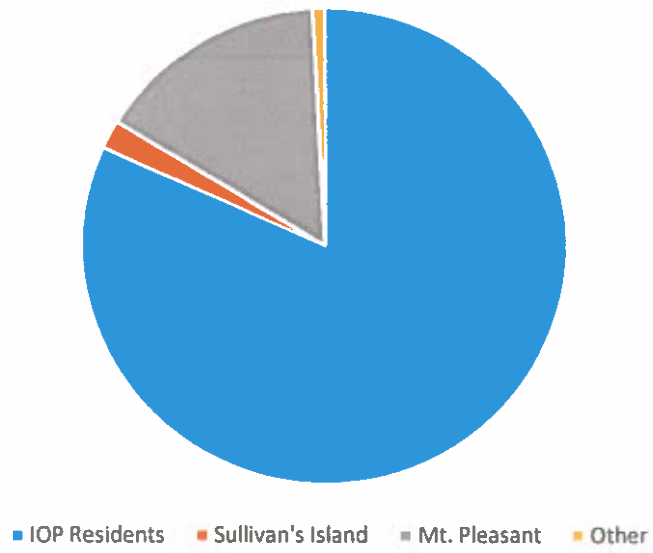
### Youth Classes February 2018



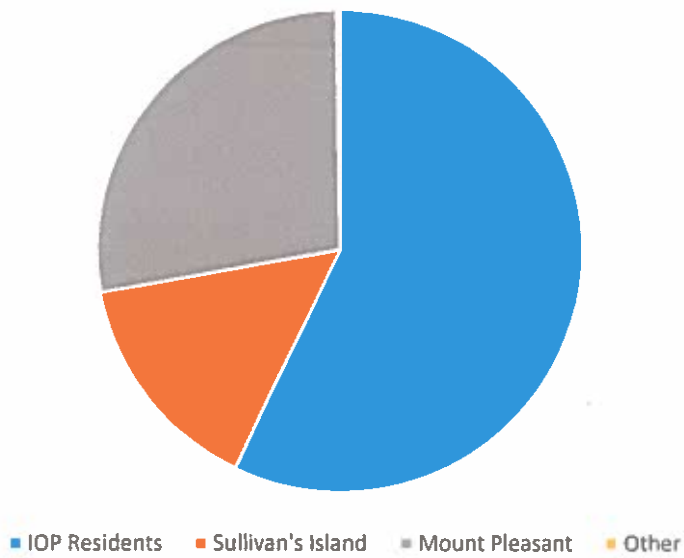
